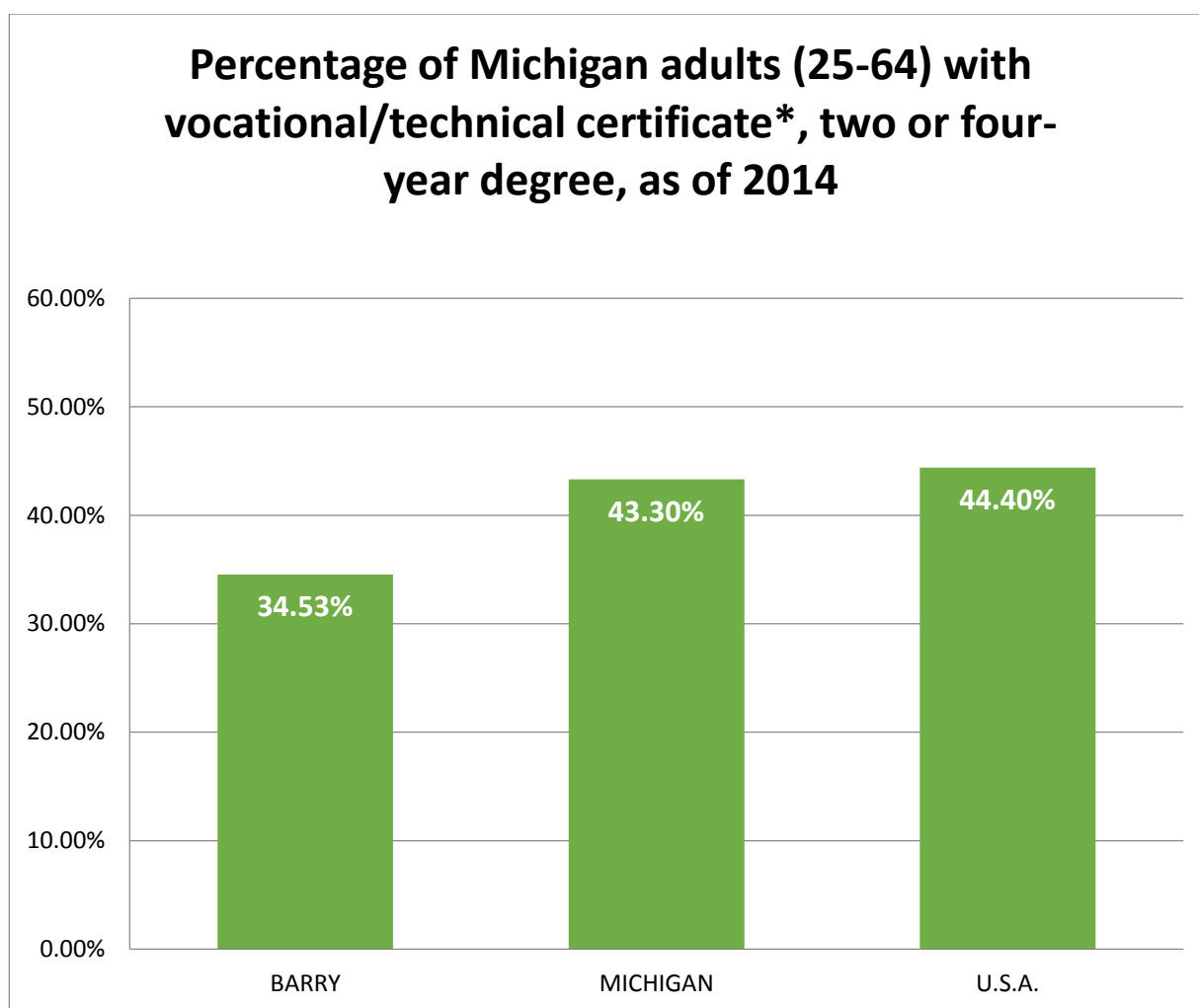
THE BIG PICTURE:

- Increase the percentage of Greater Barry County residents age 25-64 with a post-high school certification or degree.

34.53%* of Barry County resident have a post-high school certificate or degree.

Baseline data from the US Census Bureau, as of 2014, shows that Barry County is 36th (out of 83 counties) in post-secondary attainment amongst all Michigan Counties for percentage of Michigan Adults ages 25-64 with an associate's degree or higher.

* This percentage includes 4% attainment of a vocational or technical certificate.

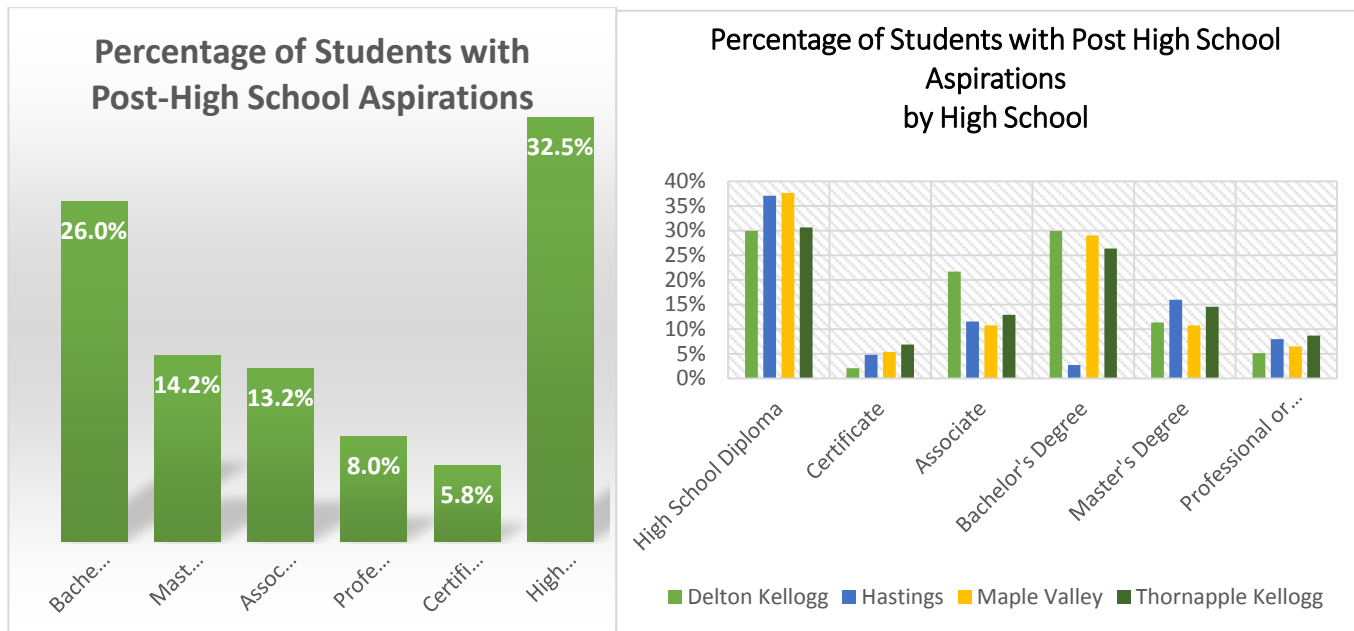

PRIORITY ACTION AREA GOAL #1

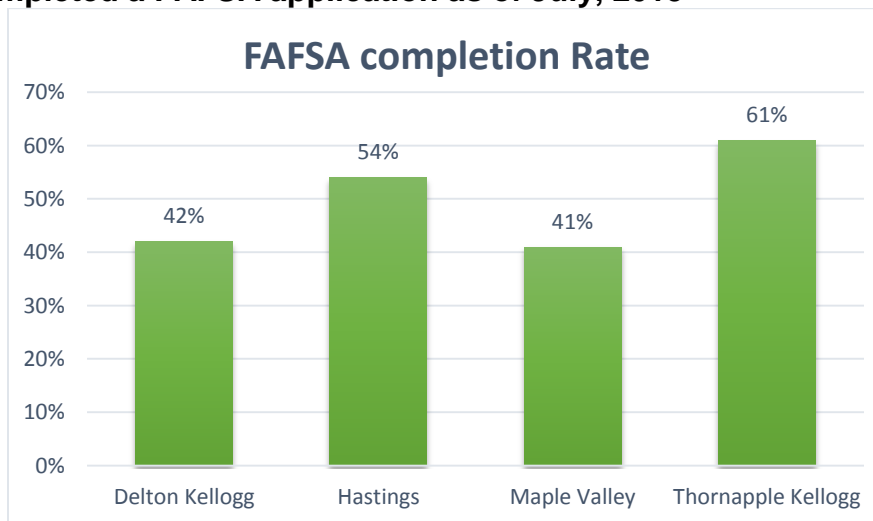
- Increase the percentage of 8th grade students of Greater Barry County aspiring to enter post-high school education, as measured by Career Cruising.
 - **67.2% of Greater Barry County students aspire to enter post-high school education for a trade/technical/vocational school certificate, two year or four-year degree or higher.**

PRIORITY ACTION AREA GOAL #2

- Increase the percentage of Greater Barry County graduating cohort who complete a FAFSA application.
 - **52.67% of graduating seniors of the 2014-15 class in Greater Barry County completed a FAFSA application as of July, 2015**
